Bowling Again

ATBSO of ACT Committee hopes that everyone is safe and in good health. It's been a harrowing time for everyone during the COVID-19 epidemic.

All National tournamnets have been postoned until 2021 as restrictions around the Nation are still in force but easing in some States. That part at least has not changed as yet.

The leagues are coming back as Zone Tuggeranong re-opens it's doors to leagues again.

The Leagues have been sending notifications of their starting times to their respective league members.

Monday Twin Singles is back on the 29th June where as Cash Triples are back on the 7th July 2020. There seems to be a return to normalcy but still a feeling of being not quite the same as before.

The ATBSO of ACT President would like to announce a Back to Bowling Tournament to be held on 26th of July 2020. The tournamnet will consist of 6 games of 3x2 game blocks, this is yet to be confirmed by our Tournamnet Director. Now that I have said it is going to be 2 game blocks, he will probably change that.

Who cares.... We are back to bowling.

Zone Tuggeranong has changed their opening times, Moday to Friday they are open from 11:00am and closing at 9:00pm.

Saturday and Sunday Opening times are at 10:00am. Another bonus.. we get to sleep in.

So our Back to bowling tournament will start at 10:30am with check in time of 10:00am. This tournament is not TBA sanctioned, however all rules and regulations must be observed as laid out by the tournament director. If you wish to participate in the Back to Bowling event, then let Rob Mason Know by 19th July 2020.

How to pay? Zone tuggeranong preferred payment is via eftpos.

Luckily we have the ability for bowlers to Direct deposit – see last page for details and let the committee worry about payment to the centre.

What about fund raising BBQ's I hear you ask. That one is still on the back burner until restrictions ease a bit more. Don't worry though all the funds raised are forwarded to 2021 National Tournament.

The National committee has been in touch with our president wanting for our tournament director to check and update everyones averages. Though no other news from them. WA, NSW and ACT will be back to bowling by mid to end of July, except Victoria of course as their situation is more dire than everyone elses, we wish them all the best in the coming months.

From Zone Tuggeranong

We have a vigorous cleaning schedule in place for the house balls and shoes to be cleaned and each lane to be sanitized after each use. Balls that have been cleaned and sanitised will have stickers over the finger holes to show that they are clean. We are asking our guests to leave used balls on the ball return rack after their game so a staff member can clean sanitize and re-rack the balls after use. This also will ensure the lane seats and surrounds are cleaned after each use by a guest.

As per usual house shoes are clean and sanitized with Glen20 after each use and rotated on our racks to ensure maximum cleanliness is ensured. We do ask our guests to bring socks however if they forget we do have them available for sale in venue.

As for your biggest concern with the ladies toilets; prior to reopening I had the plumbers come in and fix, replace and service all the ladies and gents toilets. Therefore we now have all 4 stalls in the ladies fully functioning (two are brand new) and we have provided extra soap at each sink for guests to wash their hands. Also throughout the venue there are two additional sanitising stands where guests may use after their game of bowling.

Apart from that, we also have in place that upon arrival guests will be checked in for safety and we will be asking for first name and last name and contact number. This is a requirement from ACT regulations and we will only hold this information for a maximum 28 days unless otherwise advised by ACT Health. This is only for the safety of guests in the event someone was to be contaminated we can contact our guests to inform them to get checked. This is NOT for marketing purposes and no guest shall be contacted with marketing material just so you are aware.

I am slowly making my way through contacting all league presidents/secretaries to inform them of these changes but anticipate a strong response of everyone returning very soon.

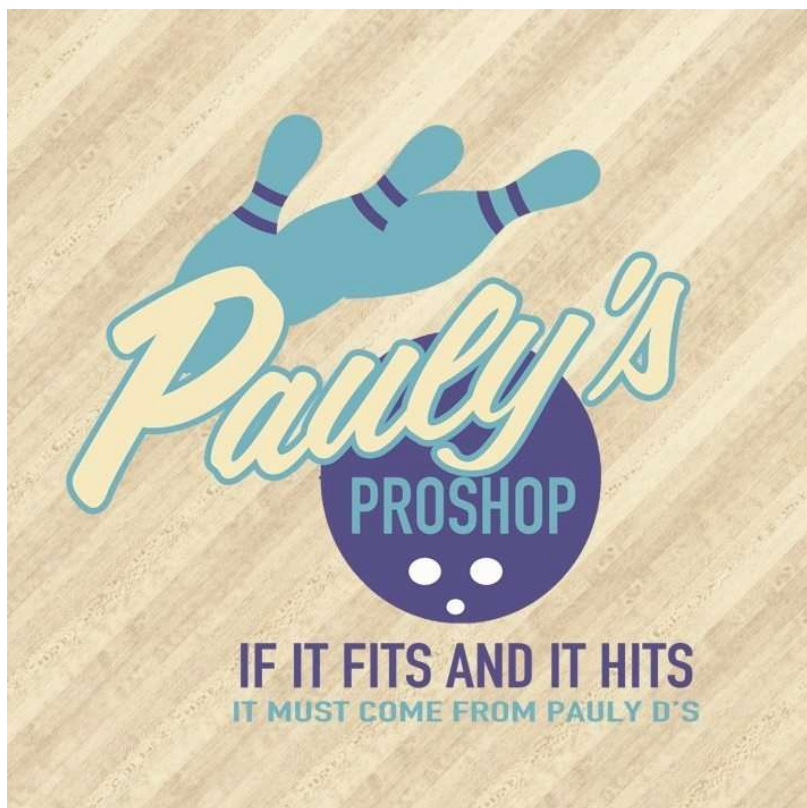
