I hope everyone had a great Christmas and a New Year. After a bit of a break our year started off with a bang with the ATBSO of ACT Championships.

It was good to see a great turnout once again from the members. And once again everyone was high spirited (drunk with happiness). This year we have had new members joining us in the Championships and also some returning old members (no pun intended) as well. Robert Mason did a great job in organising the event. I have to give a big thank you to JJ who works tirelessly not only during the event but also behind the scenes collecting the scores and entering them in the system, improving our templates and scoring system. Without these guys we would be struggling during our events. So Thank You Rob and especially JJ fantastic work guys.

At the start of the Championships, it was easy to tell that it was going to be a challenge. The day was a scorcher in the ACT and Lee Auld brought in Water on behalf of the Committee for everyone.

The All events for Men was taken out by Steve Williams, with Keith Robinson coming second. Steve bowled 566,551,559 Keith bowling 562, 566 and 501. There was only 2 pins separating the men with their combined handicap pinfall 2054 to 2052 giving them 186 and 181 scratch average respectively

Womens all events was taken out by Corrina Logan and coming in second was Kathy Johnson. Corrina bowled 557, 538 and 496, a handicap combined total of 2131 with finishing scratch average of 176.

The Triples Mens team was won by Robert Mason, Steve Williams and Keith Robinson with Johnelle Teague, Corrina Logan and Colleen Swan coming in second with 54 pins separating the two.

The doubles even was taken out by the girls Corrina Logan and Colleen Swan finishing with a handicap total of 1427.

The boys were hot on their heels with a combined handicap total of 1418. With Robert Mason scratch total of 663 and Paul Logan of 650.

The Mens Singles event was taken out by Keith Abram bowling 218,189,175 with the combined handicap total of 711. Hot on his heels was Steve Williams 177,181,201 finishing with handicap total of 685.

The Womens Singles was taken out by Lee Auld bowling 225,179,206 with the combined handicap total of 718. Marilyn Richards not far behind Lee coming in second bowling 141,169,149 with the combined handicap total of 699 separating the two by 19 pins.

The highest 3 game scratch total goes to Craigh Sproule (687).

The women high 3 game scratch goes to Lee Auld(610)

Highest game of the day goes to Paul Logan with 269.

The Highest game for Women goes to Corrina Logan with a 230.

Overall it was a great tournament and the consistency was the order of the day.

The reason for this EOGM is as follows:

ATBSO of ACT Committee would like to amend the Constitution and the Bylaws

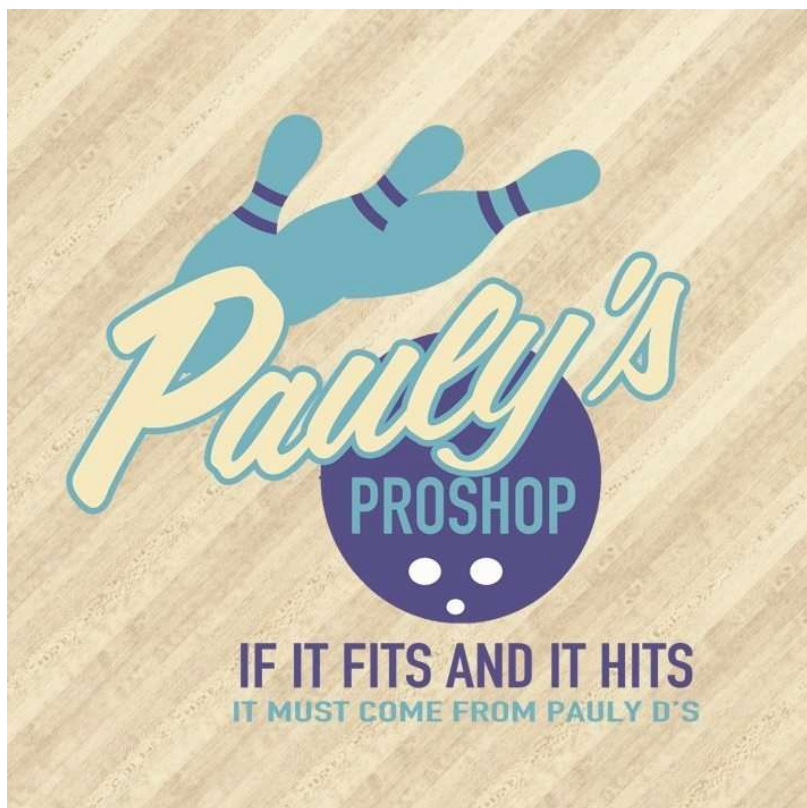
1. Change the dress code in the constitution for men and women to remove the wording "ATBSO of ACT Interstate Challenge" on the back of the shirt as this wording already appears on the front of the Shirts. Amendments are on Article 3 section C.2 and C.3
2. Amend the constitution to add General Meetings to change the constitution or the by-laws to be in line with the ACT State act.
3. Amendments to the bylaws to:
 - remove the ATBSO of ACT Championships as a compulsory event and a precursor to the rollofs(article 7).
 - Amend Article 9 and remove the wording "with one days competition to be held in each of the available centres in the ACT region".
 - Amend article 10 as per attached documents

On 25/02/2020 an email was sent out to all members with Notices of Motion attached. Please go through them before the meeting as we need to get through the whole Seven Notices.

If you wish to make changes, you are welcome to submit your own Notice of Motion but it must be received 10 days prior to the EOGM commencing
