## 2020 ATBSO of ACT AGM

### 2020 AGM Singles Event

The 2020 AGM singles event started out with a great turnout of 28 Men and women bowlers. Richard Makins made the announcement of our own Westfield Local hero winner Marilyn Richards, President of the ACT Wizards League. Marilyn has been involved with the Wizards for more than 20 years and has been president for five years and now one of 3 Westfield Local Hero Winners in the ACT with a \$10,000 grant.

Congratulations Marilyn from everyone, fantastic work.

The Singles tournament started out with some great bowling from all the members. A total of 39 200+ games were bowled during the tournament with Phil Marshal having a high game scratch of 274 for the open Men. Tony Burns scoring a 218 high game for the Restricted Men and Jenny Burton Douglas with a high game of 240 for the Ladies.

For the Open Men, Phil Marshal lead from the start with Andrew Campbell hot on his heels with only 49 pins separating the two after 4 games. Phil Marshal continued his form for the last two games to take out

the tournament for the Open Men with a massive 238 average for the day, Andrew Campbell finished second with 212 average and Damien McFarlane finishing third with a 209 average. Great bowling guys.

It was a great day for the ladies with Janet Baker taking an early lead. After the 4th game lee took the lead by 15 pins and extended the lead in the following two games. Finishing first for the Ladies with a scratch average of 201. Jenny Burton Douglas finished second with a scratch average of 191. Colleen Swan finished in 3rd place with consistently bowling over average and finished with a scratch average of 181. Great bowling Ladies.

Peter Abbey took an early lead for the Restricted Men, however, Midway through the tournament, Noel Kelly snuck in front and held the lead to finish first for the Restricted Men with a scratch average of 188. Peter Abbey finished second for the Restricted Men with a scratch average of 177. Keith Piper finished third for with a scratch average of 169.

## ATBSO of ACT AGM

From the members present at the tournament, it was easy to see we were going to have a quorum at the AGM after the singles event. Total number of members is 44, on the day of the AGM, there were 24 financial member signatories declaring a quorum for the 2020 ATBSO of ACT AGM.

The ATBSO of ACT Committee provided sandwiches and coffee prior to the opening of the AGM.

President Richard Makins Started the proceedings with the reading of the 2019 AGM minutes. The minutes were accepted Paul Logan and seconded by Andrew Campbell. The committee members presented their reports and then the AGM was on to General Business. Richard Makins stated that Cara Honeychurch has resigned her position as the CEO of Tenpin Bowling Australia (TBA). This also has impacts with the ATBSO National (ATBSON) committee talks with TBA for the last 4 years regarding the Seniors and Seniors bowling events. However we are yet to hear from ATBSON regarding the relationship between TBA and ATBSON and what it will mean for us. ATBSO National Committee does get a grant from TBA on a yearly basis but that grant amount is \$1000.00.

Treasurer Lee Auld mentioned that there will be an increase to our Tournament prices by 20 cents per game. The members agreed that the cost be absorbed by our current tournament fees.

Under discussion was the cost of nibbles and lunches. Members decided that a nominal fee for team nibbles will be ade-

quate and each team member will be responsible for their own meals.

The Christmas BBQ is once again on hold due to the COVID-19 restrictions. Hopefully we will eventually have a BBQ for our members soon, the last one was in December 2017.

There were 2 positions up for re-election at the AGM. The Vice Presidency and the Secretary Positions.

The vice Presidency position had two Nominees, Colleen Swan and Barry Harney. Both nominees were told to wait outside the room while members cast their vote. The Winner with a Majority vote was Colleen Swan.

Congratulations Colleen, Colleen will be the Vice president for the next two years.

The Second position that was up for re-election was the Secretary position. There was only one nominee for this position and it was Albin Zagar.

Albin will be the secretary for the next two years.
