This year the ACT Teams in all divisions did great at the Nationals especially the first timers.

Since this was our first national tournament since COVID hit, there are a couple of House-keeping items to address:

- Apart from the Team, Managers are only allowed in the players area.
- It was found that additional people were coaching team members, this needs to be agreed with the manager first.
- If there is a requirement for a coach, then that person is only designated to coach the team for that division and no other divisions. The coach will also need to be assigned prior to the Nationals.
- Team members are to support the team and bowl as a team rather than individuals, though, majority did great.
- Team members are also to help managers when moving lanes with equipment where possible

Next years Tournament is proposed to be held in Tasmania, this is still under discussion with Tasmania and the National committee. If Tasmania cannot hold the event then it will go to Tender.

ACT is in the position to tender for the 2023 National Games to be hosted at Zone Tuggeranong. Zone Tuggeranong confirmed they will be able to host the event.

If we are to tender, we will need to have an Events committee to organise the event, Booklets, Dinner night, list of Accommodations, engravings, medals, sponsorships etc.

The two day singles event will be held December 11 2022 again leveraging off the success of last years unsanctioned event.
